Superficial dissection of the abdominal wall

Dissection of the abdominal wall. The superficial muscles of the anterior abdominal wall are the rectus abdominis, external oblique, and internal oblique. The rectus abdominis is divided into segments by transverse lines, called the linea nigra. The external oblique is the most superficial muscle. The internal oblique is deep to the external oblique. The transverse abdominis is deep to the internal oblique. The superficial fascia is composed of the superficial fat layer and the superficial musculoaponeurotic system (SMAS).
